OPENING

All: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

PENITENTIAL RITE

All: I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do,

(And, striking their breast, they say:)

through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault;

(Then they continue:)

therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

Leader: Lord, have mercy.

All: Lord, have mercy

Leader: Christ, have mercy.

All: Christ, have mercy

Leader: Lord, have mercy.

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

1st Reading

Psalm, with responses

2nd Reading

Gospel

(Pause for Silence. Listen to a homily even.)

APOSTLE'S CREED

Leader: Let us now profess our Faith.

All: I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,

(At the words that follow, up to and including the Virgin Mary, all bow.)

who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell;

on the third day he rose again from the dead;
he ascended into heaven,
and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty;
from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic Church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body,
and life everlasting. Amen.

INTERCESSIONS

(pray for all those who need prayer and for St. Anne's.)

Leader: Let us now offer our petitions to the Lord.

Leader, or others: "We pray for, x"

All: "Lord, here our prayer."

OUR FATHER

Leader:

Bringing our prayer's and petitions into one, let us now pray the prayer our Lord, Jesus Christ has taught us:

(all pray the Our Father)

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

Leader: With desire in our heart's for receiving the Lord's Body and Blood, let us pray the prayer of desire from the Centurion:

All: Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

(All pause briefly, and then say:)

**My Jesus,
I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things,
and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You.
Amen.**

(all pause for a moment and ask the Lord to express His love for them personally)

CONCLUSION

Leader: Let us pray

(pause)

Leader: Heavenly Father, you sent your Son to us as our Redeemer, and your Holy Spirit as our Comforter; give us an abundance of your grace, and great awareness of your presence, and sure knowledge of your Love while we abide in this time of trial and want. Through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen

Leader: May the Lord bless us, protect us from all evil, and bring us to everlasting life.

(all make this sign of the cross)

Leader: Let us go in peace

All: Thanks be to God.
